



Policy for patients 18 years of age and older

As you may or may not be aware, your child, if they are 18 years of age or older, is considered an adult by law. With that being said, the law treats them as such and we are prohibited from discussing with you their dental issues including, but not limited to, treatment, billing, referrals etc., without their consent.

When your child arrives at our office, we will ask your adult child to sign an agreement allowing us to communicate with you about their dental health and other needs. We encourage you to discuss this with your child prior to their visit so that they are prepared.

This policy protects your child's rights while allowing us to communicate with you when appropriate.
